From your Aerie Secretary, Jack Young:

Your Aerie will opening back up for business Thursday, May 21st with **new temporary** hours for the **Social Room** and the **Kitchen**. The Social Room Hours are posted to the left. Kitchen hours as follows: Sunday 1:00pm-7:00pm, Monday-Thursday 12:00pm-7:00pm, Friday-Saturday 12:00-8:00 pm. There have also been many other changes so that we will be in compliance with the State and Miami County Health Department. We ask that you are patient through this re-opening adhere to these temporary changes and to the new rules.

Thanks to all who have paid 2021 Dues. Remember that Dues are due by 5/31/2020. The Grand Aerie will drop all delinquent members 6/30/2020. If dropped, then you must RE-Enroll which will cost \$15.00 plus the \$30.00 dues.

We are planning on having our next membership meeting Wednesday 7/1/2020. We will be having Nomination of offices at this meeting followed by Elections, if needed, on Wednesday 7/15/2020. Keep in mind that this may change depending on current Heath Department rules at that time.

From your Aerie Trustees, Bill Heath, Denny Hess, and Tom Jessup:

Yea, were finally going to re-open. Please adhere to our new rules and all the other changes that we had to make so we can be in compliance with the State and Miami County Health Department. The bartenders are not permitted to change any of these rules or bend any of these rules. Please do not put them in this position. WE expect that all Members will understand this and comply to all the rules. **Non-Compliance will not be tolerated!** The following are the new rules:

1 If you are symptomatic you must go home. You are not allowed to be here until all symptoms are gone.

2 This club is and for the immediate future "A MEMBERS ONLY CLUB". No exceptions! No guests will be permitted in this establishment. No children will be permitted in this establishment. Husband and wife must both be members to enter.

3 When you are not actively eating or drinking, we encourage facial covering.

4 The seating is where it needs to stay. No moving of tables, chairs or bar stool.

5 Social distancing is a must. This distance is Six Feet.

6 If a couple lives together and are both members they may sit together at the bar. Two (2) people only. Parties of (3) or more must move to a table. Tables are spaced six (6) feet apart. Parties of ten (10) or less may sit at the tables. There are designated tables for these parties. All other tables will be for four (4) people or less.

7 Remember that all members are supposed to be cleaning their tables off before they leave. This has always been a rule and it remains a rule. There are bar rags and sanitizer at the bar. Please see that you are doing this!

8 Sunday, Tuesday & Friday Drawings are all suspended for the immediate future. The Daily drawings will still be held. (Red Tickets)

9 All common areas are to remain closed. This includes the hall, card room, old kids room & billiard table. There is to be no dance floor or any entertainment.
