### From your Aerie Secretary, Jack Young:

During the 2020 Annual Meetings in Reno, Nevada, the following law changes related to membership were passed on the floor by a vote of the Aerie delegates:

The re-enrollment fee will be waived until December 31, 2020, for members who were dropped this year from the rolls. This is effective Wednesday, July 22, 2020. Any member who were charged a re-enrollment fee prior to July 22 will not be entitled to a refund.

Any member who was dropped this year who re-enrolls before the end of the current fraternal year (May 31, 2021) will be allowed to keep their years of membership. These members will still be considered "re-enrolled" and will subject to a vote of the membership but will retain their original initiation date. This includes benefit membership status, so long as they pay the proper dues amount associated with benefit membership. Any member dropped in a previous year who re-enrolls will NOT be entitled to having their years of membership reinstated.

### From your Aerie Trustees, Bill Heath, Denny Hess, and John Lyle

Please adhere to our new rules and all the other changes that we had to make so we can be in compliance with the State and Miami County Health Department. The bartenders are not permitted to change any of these rules or bend any of these rules. Please do not put them in this position. WE expect that all Members will understand this and comply to all the rules. **Non-Compliance will not be tolerated!** The following are the new rules:

1 If you are symptomatic you must go home. You are not allowed to be here until all symptoms are gone.

2 This club is and for the immediate future "A MEMBERS ONLY CLUB". No exceptions! No guests will be permitted in this establishment. No children will be permitted in this establishment. Husband and wife must both be members to enter. Wives and significant others are allowed.

3 When you are not actively eating or drinking, you need to wear facial covering.

4 The seating is where it needs to stay. No moving of tables, chairs or bar stool.

5 Social distancing is a must. This distance is Six Feet.

6 Tables are spaced six (6) feet apart. Parties of ten (10) or less may sit at the tables. There are designated tables for these parties. All other tables will be for four (4) people or less.

7 Remember that all members are supposed to be cleaning their tables off before they leave. This has always been a rule and it remains a rule. There are bar rags and sanitizer at the bar. Please see that you are doing this!

8. You must be in a seat if you are eating or drinking.
